

Poetry Takeover Challenge Terms & Conditions

1. The Poetry Takeover challenge starts on Friday 1 May 2020 at 9 am and ends on Sunday 31 May 2020 at 5 pm.
2. Students currently enrolled in South Australian schools in years 4-11 (or home school equivalent) are eligible to enter the Poetry Takeover challenge.
3. Neither the immediate family members of employees of the History Trust of South Australia nor the judges or their immediate family members are eligible to enter.
4. Entries must be inspired by an object or artwork from the collection of a museum, gallery or other collecting institution and must reflect the theme 'change'.
5. By entering, you agree that your work is original and does not infringe the copyright, moral rights or other rights of any third party.
6. Poems must be written by an individual author. Multiple entries will not be permitted.
7. Copyright of the poem remains with the poet.
8. Poem submissions can be made through the online form. Entries must include either a parent's or carer's name/email address. Entries sent by email will not be accepted.
9. Entries must not contain any swear words or any content that is discriminatory toward a particular group of people (e.g. content that is racist, homophobic or sexist).
10. By entering, you give the History Trust of South Australia and its branches permission to publish your poem on its websites and social media channels. This permission is granted under a Creative Commons Attribution Noncommercial (CC-BY-NC) license. Once published on social media, poems may be shared by third parties.
11. All submissions will be reviewed before they are published in the online gallery. The History Trust reserves the right not to publish entries if they are deemed not to adhere to the criteria set out in item 9 above.
12. The closing date for entries is **Sunday 31 May 2020, 5 pm.**
13. Prizes will be awarded in three age categories: years 4-6, years 7-8 and years 9-11.
14. Winners in each age category will receive a \$50 book shop voucher.
15. Judging will take place between 1 and 12 June 2020. Winners will be announced by 14 June 2020.
